The aim is for you to acquire the necessary language skills and specialist medical terms to comfortably communicate and work in an English speaking environment. Vocabulary around patient history, physical examination, diagnosis and diagnostic tools and therapeutic options are developed using medical articles, teaching material and case discussions and practised in conversation. Thematic foci include anatomy, cardiovascular system, gastrointestinal system, respiratory system, nervous system, urinary system, reproductive system and endocrine system and an optional session about clinical or basic medical research.

Mode of teaching:

Acquisition and consolidation of key vocabulary and pronunciation, reading/translation/writing of medical articles and clinical documentation, practice of doctor-patient interactions.

Completion:

Final test including the presentation of a disease or a patient history.

Literature:

A script containing all necessary material used in class will be made available. Additionally there will be a reading list concerning the teaching material and literature recommendations on request.
